What To Bring - Minor Bay Lodge

Fishing Gear

- FISHING ROD(S)** - We recommend bringing a rod you've used and are comfortable with.
- SPINNER(S)** - Bring a reel that has a good, easy to set drag system. This is the most important part when landing big fish.
- LINE(S)** - For pike, we recommend 10-16 lb. test line; for walleye, 4-8 lb. test line.
- LURES** - The best lure is always up to the fish on any given day. So, instead of trying to guess ahead of time, we suggest waiting to purchase lures at the lodge. We stock a great selection of jigs, spoons, spinners and cranks and can tell you what the fish are liking at that time. Fresh bait is also available.
- STEEL LEADERS** - 12-inch, 12-20lb. A must when fishing for trophy pike.
- TACKLE BOX**

Clothing and Personal Gear suggestions

You probably know most of what you need for clothing. Here are some things we recommend you don't forget:

- RAINGEAR** - A hooded coat plus pants
- WATERPROOF FOOTWEAR** - Plus a dry pair for around the lodge
- WARM JACKET** - For cool, summer nights
- SUNSCREEN** - SPF 30 or higher
- HAT OR CAP** - For sun protection
- LONG-SLEEVE SHIRT** - Also for sun protection
- SUNGLASSES** - We recommend a quality, polarized pair to help minimize water glare
- BUG REPELLANT**
- FLASHLIGHT**
- CAMERA** and film - disposable, waterproof cameras work well
- POCKET KNIFE** - If traveling by air, be sure to carry in checked baggage
- CASH** - For guide tips, fishing gear and any other purchases you may wish to make
- IDENTIFICATION** bring either:
 - A current passport or
 - Birth certificate plus current picture ID
